Coach policy

Amsterdam will introduce new rules for coaches as from 1 January 2024. The City council wants to enjoy the benefits coaches bring, while tackling the nuisance they can cause.

One way we plan to do this is by banning heavy coaches (those weighing more than 7.5 tonnes) within the S100 ring - with a few exceptions.



From when?

A new coach policy will apply from **1 January 2024**.



What will change?

- As from 2024, coaches weighing **more than 7.5 tonnes** will be banned from roads within the S100 ring road, with the exception of the corridor Weesperstraat - Valkenburgerstraat - Kattenburgerstraat.
- **Exemption** permits will only be issued for coaches carrying primary school pupils, people with disabilities, elderly and artists, and provided that they are travelling to or from educational, cultural or arts institutions.
- Coaches will be directed to parking areas and **drop-off and pick-up** facilities close to the borders of the city, preferably in the proximity of public transport.
